



Thread Trail meetings start this month

Union County is hosting a series of public open houses this month to give residents an opportunity to participate in the planning of a countywide master plan for the Carolina Thread Trail.

The Thread, a network of trails, greenways, blueways and conservation corridors linking 15 counties in North and South Carolina, offers opportunities for biking, hiking, fishing and - paddling.

The Thread is made up of segments that are designed, built and owned by the counties and towns through which the trail network is woven.

To kick off the planning process, the county will host a series of public meetings starting on July 19. The meetings will take place as follows:

- Weddington – July 19, 6-8 p.m., Weddington Swim & Racquet Club, 4315 Matthews-Weddington Road, Weddington
- Waxhaw – July 20, 6-8 p.m., Museum of the Waxhaws, 8215 Waxhaw Highway, Waxhaw
- Indian Trail – July 21, 5-7 p.m., Union West Regional Library, 123 Unionville-Indian Trail Road, Indian Trail
- Eastern Union County – July 22, 6-8 p.m., Union County Cooperative Extension, 500 N. Main St., Suite 506, Monroe

Local representatives from Union County will be available to answer questions and share information about the regional scope of the project.
