## Forsite closes on first phase of ReVenture Park property

Charlotte-based Forsite Development said Tuesday that it has closed on 304 of the 667 acres that ReVenture Park is slated to encompass.

The company, which is developing the eco-industrial park project, made the announcement Tuesday.

Also Tuesday, Tom McKittrick, Forsite's president, also said he is working with the Catawba Lands Conservancy on a 185-acre conservation easement along Long Creek basin that can connect the Carolina Thread Trail to the U.S. National Whitewater Center.

The North Carolina Wildlife Federation has certified ReVenture Park as a Wildlife and Industry Together site.

ReVenture Park will include a power plant, which will convert Mecklenburg County's trash to energy; solar fields; incubator labs; and research and development facilities, among other things.

Once developed, ReVenture is expected to generate more than \$900 million in investment and create more than 1,000 jobs.
